We were fishing two rods each, a full sink line and a floating line with dry fly. I was catching well on the full fink with a Pumpkin Head and a # 10 foam dragon fish. Then when the surface water warmed in the afternoon the dry line with a # 14/16 Griffith Gnat was a big producer. Woo, it was a good day outing. Good luck on Chemainus, should be excellent. Watch out for those Lunkers, they are a good fight!
