Dragon Fly



This was the demo pattern.

Dragon Fly Nymph

Materials:

Hook: Number 12 Streamer Mustad Hook

Tail: Pheasant Tail

Body: Deer hair

Thorax: Peacock Herl

Thread: Black thread

Alternate Pattern Materials:

Hook: I prefer 10 or 12 streamer or long shank hook. Can be tied on a larger hook, but not very practical on a smaller.

Tail: Green Goose Quill

Body: Twisted deer hair

Legs: Pheasant tail

Thorax: Peacock herl

Cap: Pheasant tail (optional) pictured fly does not have a cap

Wrap tread down the shank. Tie in Tail with one quill pointing out to each side. Twist deer hair up shank about one third. Tie in about six pheasant tail fibres pointing slightly down on each side. Twist deer hair another third . Tie in another set of legs in the same manner. (if you want to put on a cap, tie in a good portion of pheasant tail on top of shank) Tie in peacock herl and wrap to the eye of hook . Pull cap over the top and tie off.

Method of fishing fly:

Use on a fast sink line with about a three foot leader. Let sink to the bottom. Fly will float up just slightly off the bottom. Retrieve with very short slow pulls.
